

# SULPHUR SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING LOT RULES AND REGULATIONS

It is a privilege to drive and park on the Sulphur Springs High School's Campus. You will be expected to read and understand all driving/parking rules for the campus. Any violation of the driving/parking rules may result in a ticket being issued, the loss of your parking permit, or the vehicle being towed at owner's expense. All motorized vehicles are subject to the full provisions of these rules and applicable state laws.

1. All vehicles must be registered and display a CURRENT Sulphur Springs High School's Parking Permit on the driver's side dash or rear-view mirror with the permit number clearly visible. Permits are **\$5 per year**.

2. Cars on campus WITHOUT PERMITS DISPLAYED or parking in no parking zones will be subject to:

Warning Notice on Vehicle, car boot on the wheel, City of Sulphur Springs parking ticket, and/or vehicle may be **TOWED** at owner's expense

3. The driver registered with the school is responsible for the behavior of others in his/her vehicle, even if he/she is not present. If your vehicle is used to transport students off campus who do not have permission to leave, your parking privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 2 weeks.

4. Parking permit may only be used on cars registered to and driven by the student obtaining the permit. You may register more than one vehicle; however, you may only park one in the lot per day. If you wish to park more than one vehicle at a time, you will need to purchase additional permits. **THIS APPLIES TO FAMILIES WITH MULTIPLE STUDENT DRIVERS.** Failure to do so will result in immediate loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the semester. When carpooling, **ONLY** one vehicle is allowed on campus, and the permit must be displayed.

5. Automobiles should be parked in the student parking lot in designated parking spaces and within the lines. Cars parked in fire lanes, handicap zones, off-limit areas, or in an area blocking traffic may be tagged by police and/or towed at the owner's expense. **Off limit areas include all areas outside the student parking lot, including staff and areas designated VISITOR.**

6. High School police officers must be informed of any changes to the registered vehicle (i.e. change in license plate number, buying a new vehicle).

7. Speed limit on all school property is **NOT TO EXCEED 15 mph**.

8. **All TRAFFIC LAWS** are enforced. Exhibition driving (squealing tires, skidding, etc.) is prohibited and may result in loss of parking privilege or a ticket being issued.

9. Persons parking in school parking lots will be forward (nose in) in the parking spaces.

10. Driving on sidewalks, lawns or athletic fields is prohibited, you will be required to pay restitutions and you will lose parking privileges.

11. Drivers should report accidents, vandalism, or theft to the Administration, or Police immediately.

12. Abuse of the above rules, such as closed campus violation, parking in the staff or visitor spaces will result in the following disciplinary actions:

First Offense: 2-week suspension of parking permit

Second Offense: 9-week suspension of parking permit

Third Offense: Parking permit revoked

13. Students are to leave the parking lot area as soon as their cars have been parked. The lot is off limits during the school day. Students are not allowed to eat lunch in their cars or work on them during this time.

14. Students may not park outside of the designated student parking areas until 4:00 PM. If you receive a car boot, it will not be removed before 4:00PM.

15. Parking permits are the property of Sulphur Springs High School and may not be transferred or altered without administrative approval. Altered permits will be revoked a minimum of nine weeks. You may reapply for a permit and it may be issued at the discretion of the administration.

16. Search of vehicles: Parking on campus consents to the right of school officials to search that vehicle when there is "reasonable suspicion" that a search will uncover a violation of law and/or school policy/rule.

**NO refunds will be given when a permit is revoked for disciplinary issues.**
