Key Program Features

Students must begin the program in Kindergarten.

Students will learn to read and write in their native language in Kindergarten and 1st grade in their language arts classes. In 2nd grade, students will begin learning to read and write in their second language.

All math instruction is in English. All science and social studies instruction is in Spanish.

The program makes extensive use of bilingual pairs to provide students the opportunities to master both the academic content and the acquisition of a second language.

Our Two-Way Dual Language Program is based at Travis Elementary for Kindergarten through 3rd grade.
